Sir David Frost and David Paradine Television Inc produced this project. The Historic Frost/Nixon interviews were filmed in 1977, following the Watergate scandal. The interviews drew the largest audience ever for a news interview in the history of television.

The first DVD installment, the "Watergate" interview was released yesterday. An additional DVD release will likely be a deluxe version of the Frost Nixon interviews with highlights from the complete 28 hours, tentatively scheduled for release in early 2009.

The Frost/Nixon phenomenon is set to hit North America this December with the release of the Ron Howard/Universal Pictures movie based on the dramatic events surrounding this landmark interview. This film project is based on the Tony Award winning play, "Frost/Nixon," which made its debut on Broadway last March. The two lead actors in the play - Michael Sheen as Frost (Tony Blair in the movie "the Queen") and veteran actor Frank Langella as Nixon (a role which won him a Tony) – will be reprising their roles in the film. Other actors in the motion picture, written by screenwriter Peter Morgan (nominated for an Oscar for "The Queen"), include Kevin Bacon and Sam Rockwell.
